Pool Opening

Pool Opening (2 hour minimum, on average 4 hours)

The opening process consists of 2 - 3 visits over a 7-day period. The time of year and complexity of the pool factor into the number and length of visits needed.

Initial Visit Remove pool cover, clean immediate deck area and water line. Begin filling pool and start-up equipment. Test and balance water chemistry. Inspect equipment, making minor repairs if necessary. Inspect and install automatic cleaner.

Follow-up Visit(s) Clean filters and perform any additional cleaning and balancing to the water chemistry as needed. Double check equipment functionality, adjust water features, autofills, and schedules (if applicable). For saltwater pools, we will clean the salt cell and add salt if necessary.

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We strive to provide an exceptional full-service pool opening experience, which requires very little involvement from our customers. Please let us know if you have any questions regarding our opening procedures.

Pool Labor Rates

Pool Labor Rates (chemicals additional)

- Feb 16th - March 27th.....\$145 per hour
- March 30th - April 24th.....\$195 per hour
- April 27th - May 29th.....\$240 per hour
- June 1st - Dec 29th.....\$165 per hour

Drain & Clean Pool

Drain and Clean Pool.....\$1850

- Completely drain pool and clean the surface
- Replace and upgrade main drain covers with VGB approved main drain grates (if necessary)
- Begin refilling the pool
- Once the pool is filled, we will complete our pool opening process
- Price includes start-up chemicals, balancers and sanitizers
- Price excludes the addition of salt, major repair work and pool cover storage

Pool Closing

Standard Winterization \$495

- Lower water to proper winterization level
- Evacuate water from plumbing and apply pool grade antifreeze to the system
- Add winter chemical kit
- Install cover hardware and pool cover

Water Features \$65 per feature

- Winterize the plumbing for water features, including fountains and waterfalls connected to the pool

Cleaning Services \$70 per half hour

- Dip all leaves and debris out of the pool prior to covering

Portable Spa \$130

- Drain and winterize your portable spa on the same day we close the pool

Custom In-Ground Spa \$215

- Drain and winterize your in-ground spa on the same day we close the pool

Extensive Closing \$165 per hour

- Pools with vanishing edges or other extensive water features will be billed at an hourly rate of \$150 per hour plus chemicals and antifreeze

2026 Service Maintenance Plans

Weekly Pool Maintenance Plans

Weekly Pool Service (chemicals additional)

- Test and treat water
- Clean filter elements as needed
- Backwash filter weekly, if applicable
- Clean skimmer and pump baskets
- Inspect pool equipment and perform minor repairs
- Skim the water surface
- Inspect auto cleaner and perform minor repairs

\$75/week

Salt Pool Maintenance (add-on, recommended for all salt water pools)

- Weekly salt and phosphate testing
- Regular cell inspections and cleanings
- Salt addition as needed

additional \$10/week

Spa Service (add-on)

- Test and treat spa water
- Rotate filters and clean as needed
- Flush, drain, clean and refill as needed
- Clean the water line
- Vacuum up any debris
- Clean the spa cover

additional \$27/week

Vanishing Edge or Basin Feature (add-on)

- Test feature weekly, provide maintenance to associated equipment
- Net and brush the catch basin
- Vacuum if needed

additional \$20/week

Manual Vacuum Service (add-on, recommended for pools without auto cleaners)

- Manually vacuum the pool floor
- Brush down steps, swimout and corners

additional \$55/week

Twice Weekly Service (add-on, recommended for pools with high bather load, excessive vegetation or unique water features)

- Make two visits per week

additional \$41/week

Major repair work NOT included in Maintenance Plans

Weekly Spa Maintenance

Weekly Spa Service (off-season, chemicals additional)

\$60/week

- Test and treat water
- Rotate spa filters and clean as needed
- Clean the water line
- Clean debris from spa
- Clean the spa cover
- Drain, clean and refill spa every 4 months

Off Season Maintenance

Plan 1: \$82.00 per month (chemicals additional)

Pools with safety covers

- Drain rain water out of the pool
- Test the pool water and adjust the chemistry
- Flush out rain water from the skimmer and add antifreeze
- Inspect the pool equipment
- Inspect and adjust the cover

Plan 2: \$130.00 per month (chemicals additional)

Pools with tarp covers

- Includes all services in Plan 1
- Drain rain water from pool cover
- Clean leaves and debris from pool cover

Additional Items to Consider

- Pool cover replacements
- Filter element replacement (recommended every 5 years)
- Equipment valve replacement (for cracked or deteriorating handles)
